The Imperial County Employees' Retirement System is looking for interested individuals to serve on the Imperial County Board of Retirement for the 9th Seat. Member is to serve a three-year term and shall be appointed by the County Board of Supervisors. The applicant shall be a qualified elector of the county, not connected with the county government in any capacity.

Details:

- Act as fiduciary for the retirement system
- Make decisions on disability cases.
- Make decisions on Governance policies, including funding, benefits and investments.
- The Retirement Board regularly meets the third Wednesday of every month.
- Members of the Board from the General Public receive \$100 per meeting plus mileage.
- Members have the responsibility to attend a minimum of 24 hours of Board Member Education within the first two years of assuming office and every subsequent two-year period.
- Board members are encouraged to attend approved conferences and training. Registration and lodging as well as allowable expenses are paid by the Retirement System.
