## C. ICERS Legal Counsel:

#### 1. Legislative review

Mr. Waddell spoke on AB 569. The bill aims to allow public employers to negotiate contributions for supplemental retirement benefits administered by or on behalf of the exclusive bargaining representative of the employees bargaining unit. AB 569 is currently pending hearing in committee.

Mr. Waddell reported that the mention of SB-853 in the SACRS report is still omitted. Mr. Waddell stated SACRS will likely include this item in their monthly report next month.

2. County Appointment of Retirement Board Trustee.

Mr. Waddell noted that Kathleen Lang has resigned from the Retirement Board. He then briefly discussed the differing interpretations between CERL systems of the "not connected to county government in any capacity" language in section 31520.1 and suggested that the Board agendize this issue for discussion at the June meeting.
